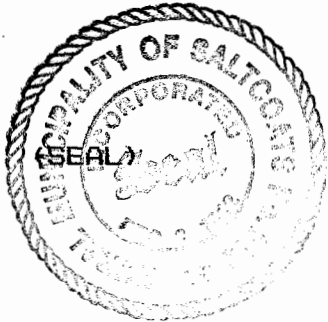




BYLAW NO. 1-94

A BYLAW RESPECTING THE BREAKING, PLOUGHING,
CUTTING, FILLING, INJURING, ENCUMBERING AND
OBSTRUCTING OF ROADS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Saltcoats No. 213, in
the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) the expression "municipal road" means any public highway that is under the direction, management and control of a municipality pursuant to Section 187 of the Rural Municipality Act 1989 S.S. R-26.1 and includes a road allowance.
2. No person shall plough, break, cut, fill or otherwise injure a municipal road or other public place in the municipality.
3. No person shall destroy, break, cut, fill or otherwise injure any vegetation on a municipal road or other public place in the municipality.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of the bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
