BYLAW NO. 7/2010


**A BYLAW RESPECTING THE SITUATING OF BUILDINGS
IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SALTCOATS NO. 213**

The Council of the R.M. of Saltcoats No. 213, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. In this bylaw:

"Road" means any road allowance within the Rural Municipality of Saltcoats No. 213 other than:
(i) a private road:
(ii) a provincial highway.
2. No building shall be situated a distance of less than 46 meters (150 feet) from the centerline of any road.
3. No building shall be situated a distance of less than 92 meters (300 feet) from a road intersection centerline.
4. Notwithstanding section 2 of this bylaw, Council at its discretion may permit, due to existing physical circumstances peculiar to the site and upon application to council, a building to locate closer to the centerline of a road.
5. This bylaw does not apply with respect to buildings situated prior to the passing of the bylaw.
6. Bylaw No. 11-86 is hereby repealed.
7. Any person guilty of any infraction to any provisions of this bylaw shall upon summary conviction, be liable to a fine as per the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.

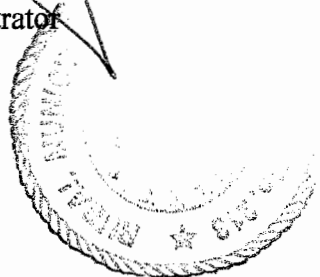
